It doesn't matter whether the piece is bowl-based or spindle-based.

Many of you will recall that for an earlier President's Challenge to produce an atypical wig stand, some people turned off-centre stems.

If you have never attempted an off-centre piece, the Guild's workshop on Saturday 19th September will be focused on off-centre turning to help you get started, and to help you come to grips with the fact that this approach to turning is not as daunting as it first seems.
